

## Remi Technology Official Statement in Support of the International Day of Family Remittances 2026

Remi Technology, a participant of the United Nations Global Compact #ForwardFaster initiative, proudly supports the 2026 International Day of Family Remittances (IDFR) and its theme: **"Remittances for Rural Resilience, Entrepreneurship and Employment"**.

We are committed to advancing UN Sustainable Development Goal 10.c: to reduce transaction costs of migrant remittances to less than 3% by 2030 and eliminate remittance corridors with costs higher than 5%. Currently, the global average cost of sending \$200 stands at 6.4%, more than double the SDG target, meaning migrant families lose billions of dollars annually to unnecessary fees.

Our bank-governed blockchain settlement infrastructure features protocol-level compliance, MiCA-licensed bank-issued Electronic Money Tokens (EMT), and full alignment with Basel SCO60 and FATF standards. This enables us to reduce cross-border settlement time from 2-3 days to under 3 minutes while maintaining the highest levels of regulatory compliance.

We are currently preparing to launch a pilot project in Southeast Asia, in partnership with local governments, banks and payment providers, to deliver fast, low-cost remittance services to 10,000 migrant workers. This pilot will focus on underserved rural communities, where remittances are most critical for household resilience and local economic development.

We invite the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) to join us as a strategic partner in this initiative. Together, we can demonstrate how regulated digital finance can transform remittances from simple money transfers into powerful tools for sustainable development.

Remi Technology commits to providing regular progress updates and sharing our learnings and best practices with the global IDFR community.
